# **MINUTES**

#### **BUSINESS** -

- 1. Presentation by OSP on State Strategies update
  - David Edgell, Office of State Planning explained that the Comprehensive Plans in Delaware began in 1999 and are updated every 5 years. He added that the State plan has just been completed for 2020 and is awaiting Governor Carney's signature.
  - Comprehensive Plans use the Census and Delaware Population Consortium to help collect data. They are used to help project the 20 year projection.
  - The Land Use data currently being used is from 2012. DelDOT has paid for an update to be the 2017 aerials and should be being published this week.

#### 2. Other Business

- Covid 19 has delayed the funding for the Census and will not have projections until the last week of August.
- Houses are being built but existing houses are being vacated. Household sizes are getting smaller but houses are increasing in size.
- Discussion was had on how Covid 19 will affect the Census, population, demographics, and land use.
